EUROPEAN KNOWLEDGE REPOSITORY FOR BEST AGRICULTURAL PRACTICES

EUREKA is a Horizon 2020 project that will improve the connections between multi-actor project partners and secure that output from multi-actor projects reaches relevant usergroups

THE MAIN OBJECTIVES OF EUREKA ARE:

- to co-create a stronger EU wide agricultural knowledge base on the multi-actor (MA) approach
- to reinforce an active and engaged multi-actor project community
- to select and make accessible the most relevant and high impact agricultural MA project knowledge for the rural and scientific community via an open source database: The FarmBook
- ensure the longevity and better sharing of MA material and research outputs to enhance wider, cross-sectoral long-term use

WHAT WE DO:

- Map and evaluate activities and outcomes of all (120-150) MA projects under Horizon 2020
- Learn from these MA projects to identify do's and don'ts
- Define the most important 'archetypes' of user groups including their data needs, barriers, preferred channels and behaviors
- Implement an EU wide agricultural knowledge base, the FarmBook, connecting outputs of MA projects with each other and to other relevant existing databases
- Communicate the EUREKA outcomes to the farming and agricultural research societies reinforcing and facilitating an active and engaged multi actor project community

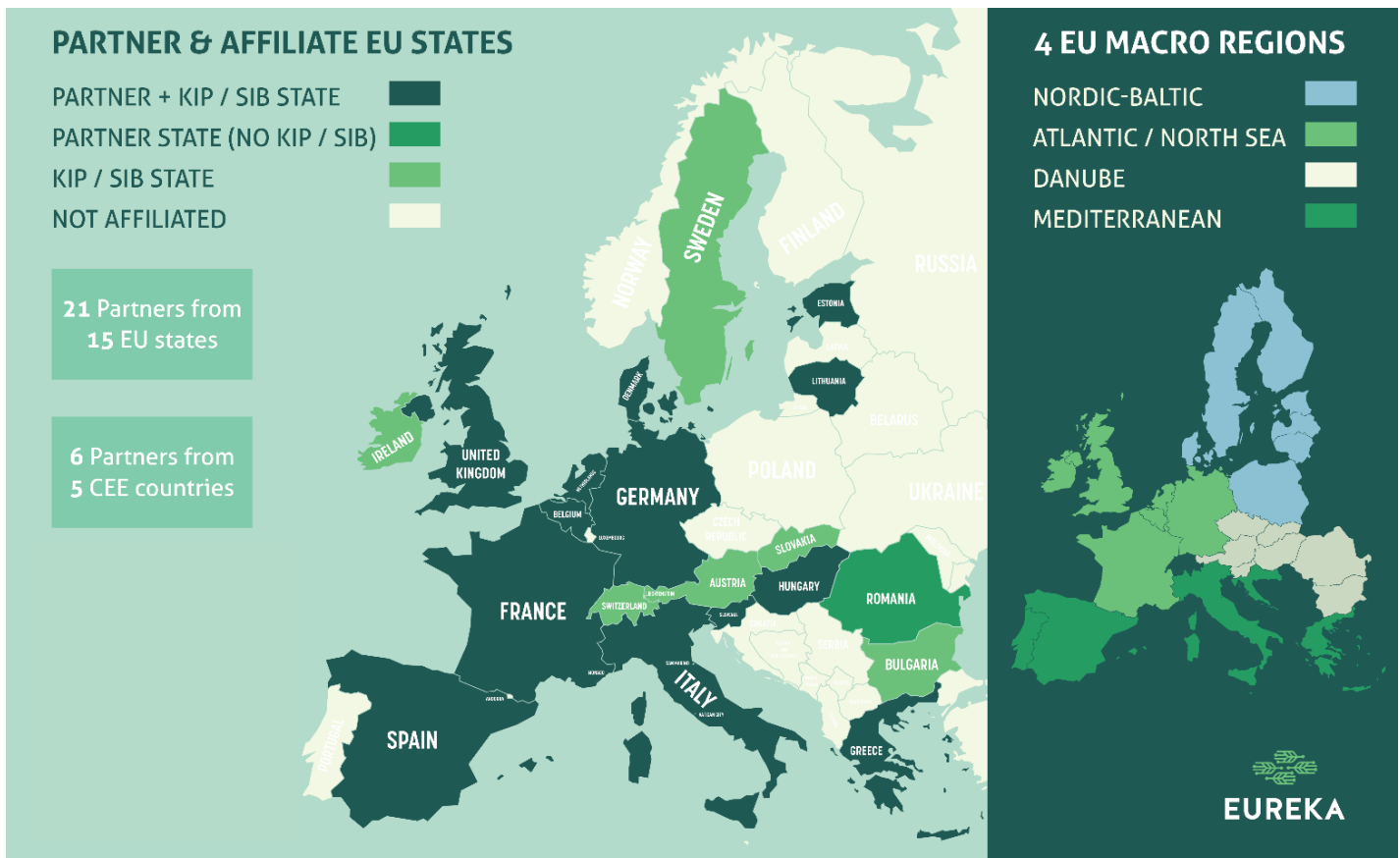
HOW:

EUREKA will develop a MA community supported open source e-platform, FarmBook building on a mapping of the knowledge demand of relevant users of the knowledge produced in these projects - and by the harvest of best practice from more than 120 MA projects.

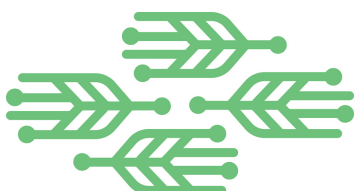
WHO WE ARE:

EUREKA builds on the experience gained in the EURAKNOS project, where best practices from all Horizon 2020 projects with a Thematic Network approach were gathered in a knowledge repository. **See euraknos.eu**

EUREKA is coordinated by Ghent University, Belgium, who also headed the EURAKNOS project. Approx. 50 % of the partners in EUREKA also participated in EURAKNOS, thus securing that key lessons learned are transferred between the projects.
